

Bert Brown, age 66, for more than 50 years a citizen of Douglas County, died at his home in Eudora Wednesday night at 10 o'clock. Death was due to a heart attack. Funeral services will be held at the Methodist church, Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock, with the Rev. W.O. Watson in charge. Burial will be in the Eudora cemetery. Bert Brown had lived in Eudora for more than 40 years where he operated a barber shop. He was born November 26, 1873 in Iowa. June 27, 1891 he was married to Miss Lulu Perkins of Eudora.
